



The purchase and acquisition of a division also requires a transfer of the engineering and CAD data (carve-out). Together with the Swiss PTC reseller and service partner GIA Informatik AG, Software Factory experts have carried out this transfer for the second time with their migration tools for Windchill. After a very successful Creo data migration, including the history from the PDM System Profile a few years ago, the task fell on Software Factory to carve out the NX CAD data from Teamcenter and import it into the customer's productive Windchill. With the Software Factory Migration Tools, there is no downtime for the users in the target system and a minimal frozen zone in the source system for changes at the end of the migration.
